Rounding Round-Up

To round any number, follow these simple rules:

Underline the place value you are rounding to.
Circle the digit to the right of the underlined digit.
If the circled number is 0, 1, 2, 3, or 4 the underlined digit stays the same.
If the circled number is 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 the underlined digit goes up by 1.
The circled digit and all digits to the right become a zero.
